### **GENERAL AGREEMENT**

In consideration of the acceptances of this entry and the holding of the event and the opportunity to have the dog participate or be judged, I/We agree to hold the organizing committee, the organization which it represents, including its members, officers and directors, the Agility Association of Canada, sponsors of the event, owners of the premises upon which the event is being held and their employees, harmless from any claims for loss or injury which may have alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any persons or thing by the act of this dog(s) while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near entrances thereto, and I/We further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claims for loss of this dog(s) by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog(s), whether such loss, disappearance, theft or otherwise be caused by or alleged to be caused by negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. I/We hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting thereof, sustained by any person or persons, including myself/ourselves or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my/our participation in this event, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other parties.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### AAC DOG ID CARDS

In order for your dog to compete, your dog must have an AAC ID Card. Please order before the trial and allow 6 weeks to receive it. Once your dog has been measured twice and signed by the judges, it will eliminate the need for measuring when competing in further trials. Forward the application for the dog's card directly to the address on the form including the prescribed fee.

### TRIAL ENTRY FORM

The entry form is to be completed, signed, dated and returned to the Trial Secretary indicated on the form with the appropriate entry fee(s). The fee for each Individual Class is \$14.00 and cheques are to be made payable to Huckleberry Hounds Dog Sports. *All registrants are required to assist with the trial and a sign-up sheet will be available on trial day.*

### CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

**Starters Standard Class** – This class is for dogs that have not earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title. Dogs having completed three clear courses defined by the AAC Rules and Regulations will be awarded the ADC title.

**Jumpers Class** – The dog's natural jumping ability is demonstrated in this class. The dog is required to complete a course comprising of hurdles and tunnels prescribed by the judge.

**Snooker Class** – This game demonstrates the handler and the dog's versatility as they work together against the clock. The object of the game is to accumulate as many points as possible in the opening and closing sequences within the allotted time.

**Gamblers Class** – This game demonstrates the handler's strategy and the dog's ability to work at a distance from the handler. The object is to accumulate as many points as possible during opening sequence and successfully complete the gamble.

**Challenge** – This class is for those who have completed the Masters.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **NOTICE TO PARTICIPANTS**

Participants through entry submission, acknowledge they are familiar with the AAC Rules and Regulations, including, but not limited, the following:

- (a) This event is held under AAC Rules and Regulations (as of January 1, 2004) and is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs showing signs of aggression.
- (b) Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the Rules and Regulations of the AAC and shall conform to AAC specifications.
- (c) No leads, collar, food, toys or any other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, including obstacle familiarization.
- (d) It is understood the entrants alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be paid.
- (e) All dogs must be kept in their ex pen, crate or be on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be in control when leaving the ring after their run. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out-of-control behavior upon exit of the ring will be disqualified and/or be required to leave the show grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be paid.
- (f) Entrants must keep crate and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourselves and your dog(s).
- (g) There will be no refunds, cancellation or changes after the closing date, except for bitches in season and move ups as per AAC regulations.
